

Mr. G. W. van Stein Callenfels (The Metals Society 会長)

Godefridus Wilhelmus van Stein Callenfels was born at Duseen (Brabant) on the 26th of October, 1917. In 1936 he started his study in physical engineering at the University of Technology in Delft, where he graduated in 1942.

In 1943 he entered the service of Hoogovens. After working for some years within the metallurgical and the fuel technology department of the research—and works laboratories he was appointed Head of the Research Laboratories in 1955.

At the merger of Hoogovens and Hoesch into Estel he was nominated Director for Coordination of Steel Technology. In 1974 he was appointed Managing Director of Hoogovens IJmuiden BV.

At present he is president of The Metals Society (London) for the year 1979/1980.

He is also one of the Founders of the International Flame Research Foundaiton (1949) and has been General-Secretary of this organization from 1955 until 1973. He is also a member of the Steering Committee of the European Nuclear Steelmaking Club.
