

1) What's ORCID?

ORCID is ...

The database of individual researcher's research activities

- The “**ORCID iD**” which is unique to each individual eliminates the problems of the same names, common in other databases, and allows others to distinguish your own research activities.
- The source of all records is indicated, ensuring the authenticity of the records through the notation of the data source name.
 - * Data registration by yourself is also possible (with some exceptions).
- The ORCID records can be linked to various databases.
- In addition to your research activities such as publication information, your peer-review records are also registered if the journals take that option (confidentiality is maintained).

Anyone can register for free.
It only takes a minute to register!

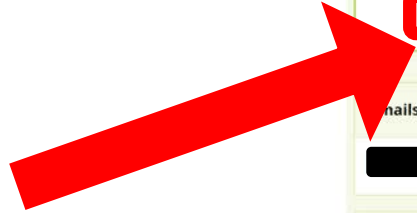

After the release of v4.23, ScholarOne Manuscripts requires positive consent from system users regarding its Privacy Policy.
